301. Château Champ de Grenet, 2004 16.00
While many Bordeaux producers continue to flounder, claret devotees should cheer themselves up with this elegant, cedary and surprisingly refined merlot-based bordeaux with a dash each of cabernets franc and sauvignon.
302. Cotes du Rhone Domaine de Montine 17.50
The use of the Cotes du Rhone grape varieties in the Languedoc can produce stunning results, as the "terroir" is much better suited to wine production. A lovely fruit driven example here, with blackcurrant and raspberry fruit. The palate is smooth, perfumed and elegant, with a tremendous sweet finish.
303. Château Buisson Redon, 2003 17.50
Dark berry fruit on the nose, with a well structured palate that is soft and ripe with a hint of blackcurrant.
304. Les Tourelles, de Sipian 2001 - Medoc 19.50
Spicy Cabernet fruit bouquet with some toasty oak. Stylish, elegant palate with lively early flavour and complex fruit with a quite firm tannin finish. Good delicate ripe fruit complexity with good structure.
306. Château Mondotte - Bellisle, 2006 - St Emilion 19.50
A deep purple colour with nuances of fuchsia. The bouquet is fine and fruity, complex with aromas of cherry, pepper and mint. Good body and well balanced.
307. Châteauneuf du Pape, 2004 - Domaine du Grand Tinel 27.50
Typically smoky, ripe berried Grenache character with a hint of jamminess. A traditional spicy wine with a firm finish.
308. Margaux, 2002 - Martinens 39.50
Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Perfume and elegance on the nose with bloody, black fruit on the palate. Crisp acidity and powerful tannins - a long intense finish rounds off this good example of Margaux style.

309. Chianti Classico Cigliano 2007 21.50
Well balanced with smooth dark cherry flavours and a lovely hint of French oak on the finish.

Spain

310. Rioja Vega Crianza Bodegas Muerza 2007 19.00 11.00
Magnificent concentration of ripe, moreish fruits, sturdy structure and beautifully weaved tannins.
311. Rioja, Monte Real Gran Reserva, 1998 - Bodegas Riojanas 37.50
A soft nose with subtle complexities, brambly fruit and smoky vanilla aromas. On the palate, sweet fruit and beautifully integrated oak and soft tannins.

Australian

312. Shiraz – Pitchfork Estate – McLaren Vale 17.00
A vibrant, distinctive Shiraz with concentrated spicy black berry fruit and a hint of vanilla on the smooth finish.

Chile

313. Cabernet Sauvignon – Los Vilos 15.00
Attractive and intense deep, brilliant red ruby. Aroma of cherries and plums with light vanilla tones. Medium bodied, young, expressive with mature tannins and evolved notes give a long lasting and fruity finish.

South Africa

314. Pinotage – Drakensberg Estate – Western Cape 15.00
A medium bodied dry red with an approachable earthy and berry fruit aroma.

New Zealand

315. Pinot Noir – Paua Bay – Malborough 21.95
This wine has a vibrant colour with raspberry and strawberry flavours and a subtle oak influence.

Piedmont – Italy
The wine displays a flavour that is simply and warmly fruity, with notable balance and a satisfying and deliciously well rounded character.
