211. Riesling, Best's 14.00

311. Opal Ridge, Shiraz Cabernet, 2004 14.50
This wine has aroma of spice and blackpepper with undertones of chocolate and cherry characters. A soft and easy drinking wine with good balance and palate length.
312. Black Shiraz, 15-03, 2003 - Beelgara 16.50
15-03 is about maximum flavour, achieved by leaving the fruit to ripen on the vine until sugars and flavours peak. A robust wine that is robust and generous, yet surprisingly smooth. The intense black cherry and plum characters are beautifully balanced by soft oak.
313. Pinot Noir, Echo Point, 2002, Crest View Estate, South Australia 16.50
A sweet, lifted nose displaying sappy wild cherry and spicy strawberry fruit is immediately inviting. The palate is then satisfied with soft, round and long flavours of strawberry and some stalkiness and light tannins.

California

314. Woodbridge, Merlot - Robert Mondavi, 2001 15.00
This Merlot has lively cherry and blackberry flavours with nuances of cocoa, anise and violets. Spicy oak notes weave through the silky texture.

Chile

315. Palo Alto, Cabernet Sauvignon, Francisco de Aguirre, 2003 13.00
Classic blackcurrant leaf bouquet. Balanced complex taste of vanilla and oak.

South Africa

316. Klippenkop Pinotage, 2003 14.50
Produced in a robust, yet early drinking style. This wine comes from Robertson, in the heart of the Cape Winelands.
